



Wedding inquiries: FAQ

Do you edit all of our photographs? and will you do a 'shoot and burn' wedding for a budget price?

I edit every photo I deliver to you. Each and every photograph you receive has been hand edited by me, one at a time, with professional software. I do not believe in 'shoot and burn' wedding photography. It is important to me that you receive quality photos to commemorate your wedding day, and it is my job to ensure that happens!

How far will you travel?

Travel completely depends on the context. Contact me with an inquiry.

Can we have photos in black and white and color?

Absolutely! Let's talk about what you want prior to the Big Day and I am more than happy to accommodate your preferences. Once images are delivered however, they won't be changed. I typically use black and white, greyscale and color interchangeably depending on the situation to best portray the image.

How many photos will we receive?

I typically deliver between 600-800 photos for full-day coverage, including getting ready, ceremony and reception, but please be aware that the number of photographs delivered depends largely on the wedding specifics. Every wedding is unique; photos depend on the wedding coverage package you choose, the number of guests, the venue and the duration. We will get more into detail about the number of photos you can expect after your consultation. No number of photos is guaranteed.

What is the 'online gallery' you provide?

The online gallery is supported by shootproof, and is a password protected gallery where you and your guests (if you choose) will be able to view and order prints of your finished photos from a professional printer. It is a secure shopping cart that allows you access to a professional printer where you can easily choose from canvas, metal or photo paper prints in all sizes. It is also an easy place for your guests to view your photos without having to order a print. I typically support online galleries for the duration of two



months after photo delivery. See the information page for details about the kinds of prints you can order.

Do you require a shot list?

I like to understand what important moments you want captured that I may not inherently know about (for example: Uncle John and his great grandson Henry together). We will go over these details in your consultation and the weeks leading up to your wedding, but I typically do not require or desire a shot list. The reason for this is simple; shot lists take away the organic and unique nature of the photo. It is hard to capture the significant and little moments when I am concentrating on ticking off a shot list that was derived from moments that aren't in the *now*. I can assure you that I will capture significant moments and details- like the lace on your dress, the flowers on the cake, and the carefully crafted table settings and signs, but if there is something extraordinary that you would like, then please do tell me!

Do you shoot the rehearsal dinner or brunch?

Rehearsal dinner, brunch and engagement coverage is an add-on to the basic wedding packages. We can discuss these add on possibilities when you contact me.

Can you make a wedding photo book?

Yes! We can discuss this particular add on when we talk. I like to get a perspective of what your needs are and then I will deliver you some package options for you to choose from that accommodate your preferences.

How soon will we get our photos?

I typically deliver photos within 6-8 weeks and have even been known to deliver within 4 weeks!

What methods of payment do you take?

Cash or check. At this time, I cannot take credit cards.
